Imagine yourself at the Hope & Anchor on a Tuesday (Nov. 2) after you'd drunk yourself into the ground and I'll begin ... At a quarter to nine the assembled Punks poured themselves down the stairs leading to the downstairs bar & The Stare, and .After we'd posed around for twenty minutes the Band appeared and started to play. THIS WAS IT (LAH) LY FIRST TASTE OF NEW WAVE ROCK. Suddenly (after a minute) Rat Scabies kicked his drums over and they dashed off stage ...
